

Afandina Dahabyia

The Dahabyia named " Afandina" is a traditional sailing vessel of the Nile. These small sailing boats plied the trade routes up and down the river Nile, and today it reminds us of a world from long ago when life was gentle and time seemed to stand still. The "Dahabyia Afandina" runs by the power of wind, though in times of stillness we have a small tug motorboat, to tow it until the winds pick up once more.

CABINS
