Accommodation

Discover the essence of tranquillity and elegance in our 18 beautifully designed cabins and suites. With two Royal Suites, two Presidential Suites and 14 luxury cabins, you are guaranteed to be cocooned in elegance. The Sanctuary Sun Boat III offers guests indulgent and opulent interiors where comfort and style are reflected inside and on deck to give a beautiful and natural look.

The 14 luxury cabins are all appointed with old fashioned four poster beds, draped with Egyptian linens. The shutters are the traditional focal point of the cabin and are a striking design element.

Every cabin is fully air-conditioned and has a beautiful Nile view plus private bathroom with bathtub, shower and hairdryer, mini bar and LCD television with satellite. International telephone access is available through the reception.

Facilities

The Sanctuary Sun Boat III has an upper sun deck known as 'Cleopatra's Oasis' with a swimming pool, a shaded deck, the Sahara lounge and H. Carter lounge bar. The Copper Tray restaurant is spacious and seats 36. In addition, there is a games room with computer and internet access.





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On board activities

Entertainment schedules during cruises are adjusted according to the needs of each group of guests and the exact sailing schedule. However, every cruise on the Sanctuary Sun Boat III includes a colourful 'galabeya party' which gives guests the opportunity to dress up in traditional Egyptian clothing and dance to Arabic music. There is also a performance by a belly dancer, accompanied by a whirling dervish show.

On board payments

The total bill should be paid at the end of the cruise in Egyptian Pounds or US Dollars. We accept travellers cheques, Visa, MasterCard and American Express. Passengers do not need to carry cash on board.

Electricity

All cabins have 220 volt electrical outlets.

Dress code

A casual dress code is in effect. It is requested that shoes, shirts and trousers/shorts are worn in the lounge, dining room and library, and that gentlemen wear long trousers for dinner and a jacket for the farewell dinner.

Safety and security

A doctor and fully equipped medical kit are on board. All staff are trained in First Aid and Crisis Management. Smoke detectors are installed in all cabins with fire hoses and extinguishers in all public areas.
